

**ADVISORY ON COVID-19: MALAYSIA EXTENDS MOVEMENT CONTROL ORDER
(MCO) PERIOD UNTIL 14 APRIL 2020**

Sunway Hotels & Resorts' Operations in Malaysia Remains Open

Sunway City Kuala Lumpur, Malaysia; 25 March 2020 – The Government of Malaysia today announced the extension of the Movement Control Order (MCO), which started on 18 March 2020 to be continued until 14 April 2020. Sunway Hotels & Resorts' operations in Malaysia will remain open with limited services and facilities access

As per the earlier MCO directives, Sunway Hotels & Resorts in Malaysia will be restricting operations and access to all facilities and services for current in-house hotel guests only. In light of the Covid-19 pandemic and for precautionary measures, all hotel's restaurants, lounges and bars will be closed while recreational facilities will have limited access and/or closed; adhering to the Government's strict protocol on social distancing guidelines. Guests are encouraged to order from the existing In-Room Dining menu available 24 hours.

In addition, all Sunway Hotels & Resorts in Malaysia will not be accepting new room reservations and/or check-in for stay period from 18 March until 14 April 2020.
